Market Data

Monitor market activity specific to your company's industry, sector and peers, and identify relevant trends that may impact your company's performance. TSXconnect enables you to understand what the broader market is doing and how your company compares.

Quotes - View up to 80 different lists of trading instruments, which you can organize as individual customer portfolios, baskets or industry groups. Quotes allow you to retrieve pricing on Canadian, US, and international trading instruments.

Charts - Plot your company's share price movement over time against your peers or an index. Use a wide variety of technical and fundamental indicators that help you realize the strengths of technical analysis.

StreetEvents - Track and monitor events. Our comprehensive calendar includes corporate earnings announcements, conference calls, webcasts, sell-side conferences, and analyst meetings originating from more than 5,000 public companies, 500 ADRs, and over a thousand sell-side brokerage firms.

Trades-Quotes - View details of all transactions and quotations for any trading instrument within a designated time frame. For each trade you will be able to identify the market participants, price, volume, and time.

Broker Summary - Identify the buying and selling activity of specific brokers for any TSX or TSX Venture Exchange listed security.

Company Information

Analyze and compare ownership, mean earnings estimates and event information on your company and your peers.

First Call Estimates - Evaluate analyst mean estimates for your company. Available metrics include: EPS, EBITDA, net income, revenue, ROE, and more.

Shareholders - Access advanced professional IR tools for institutional intelligence. Through the Current Holders report, you can identify and view ownership by Institution, Mutual Fund, or the Parent/Fund designation for your company and peer group.

Short Interest - See the number of shares sold short and short interest ratios for your company.

Corporate Actions - Provides a history of a company's corporate actions including dividends, splits and reorganizations.



Tools

Research domestic and international trading instruments, view and compare the investment returns and track recent alerts.

Total Return - Quickly calculate and chart the total return of your company's share price over a user-specified period. You simply input the company ticker symbol, number of shares owned, buy date, sell date and reinvestment rate to calculate the total return. The feature then calculates price appreciation, as well as dividends received over a specified time.
